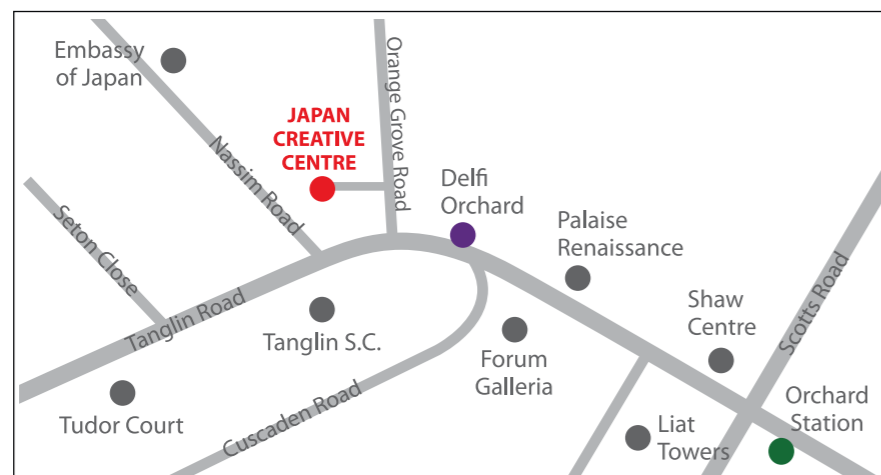

Welcome to the Japan Creative Centre.

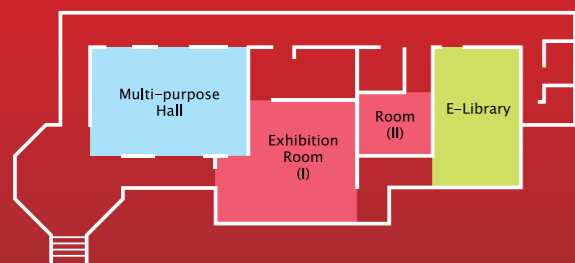
The Japan Creative Centre was officially opened by Prime Ministers of Japan and Singapore, with "Innovation & Tradition" as its main theme, the Centre introduces Japan's "soft power" and created a space where visitors can experience the charm of Japan. The centre aims to disseminate information about Japan to a broad area including Singapore and neighbouring Southeast Asian Countries.

The Centre is Available for Use by the Public

The centre (450m², single storied) is ideally located at the start of Orchard Road (No.4 Nassim Road), which is the heart of Singapore's commercial and shopping district. It has a multi-purpose hall that accommodates about 50 seats, E-library installed with computers and audio-visual equipment and two exhibition spaces.

JCC Facilities

Facilities are available for use by individuals or organisations who wish to co-organise Japan related events and activities with JCC free of charge

Multi-Purpose Hall (8.9m x 6.4m)

With a seating capacity of 50, the Multi-purpose Hall is ideal for networking events, seminars, lectures, workshops and cultural demonstrations and sharing sessions. Several equipment are available for your use:

- a. Projector
- b. Sound system
- c. DVD player
- d. Picture rail
- e. Special lighting
- f. Podium

Exhibition Room (6.1m x 5.0m & 4.0m x 3.6m)

Exhibition Rooms I and II, which serve as suitable venues for private exhibitions, are installed with the following audio-visual equipment:

- a. Large screen TV
- b. DVD player
- c. Picture rail
- d. Special lighting

E-Library

The E-Library boasts of a growing collection of Japanese music, film, anime and documentary DVDs as well as books related to art and culture which can be enjoyed at the Centre (please note that they are not available for loan). The E-Library is equipped with the following features:
