- Basic information on the Ibaraki prefecture



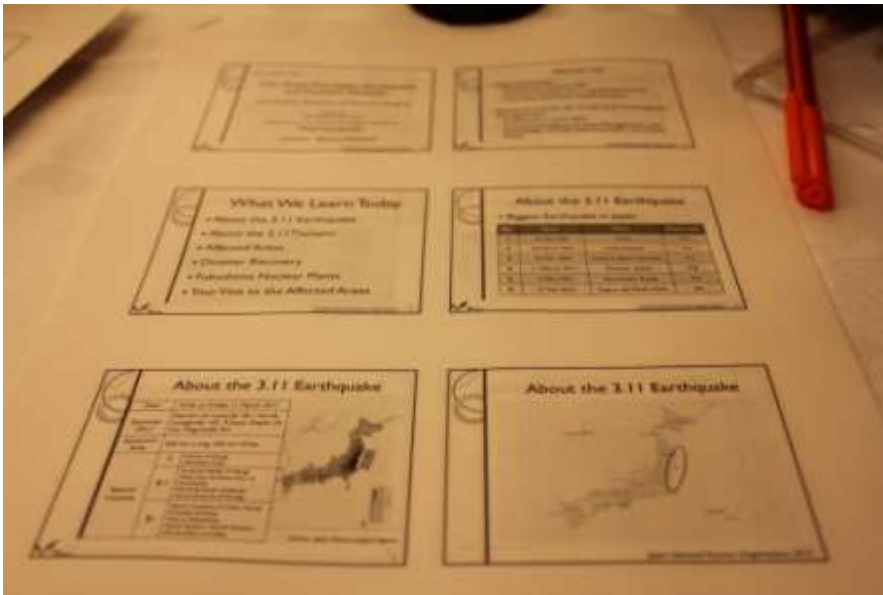
Day 2

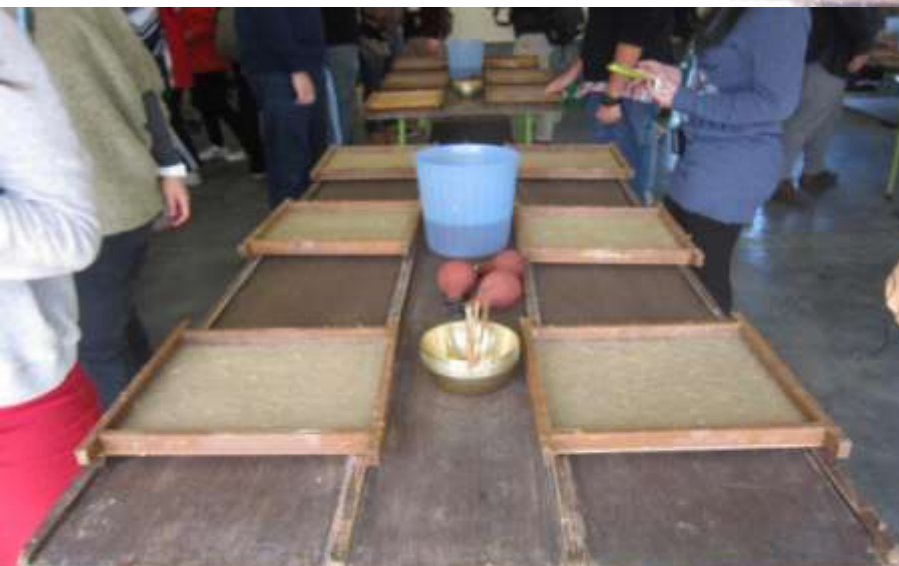

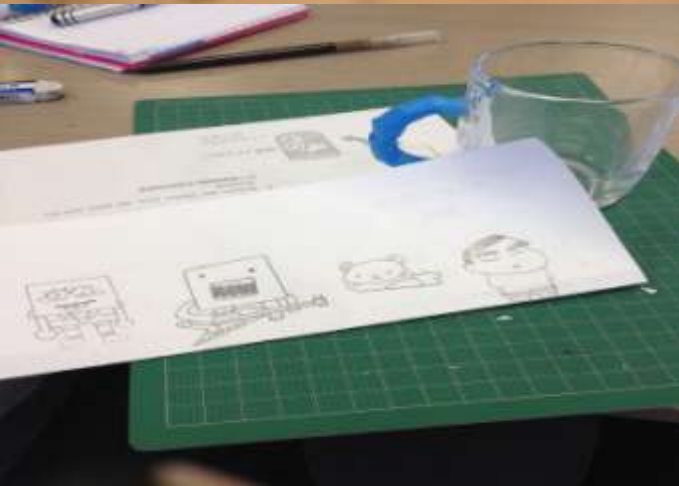
LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- Otsu Port is the major base port of round-haul net fishing boats in Ibaraki
 - Tsunami submerged everything up to 200 metres away
 - Stop shipment and fishermen refrained from fishing voluntarily
- Revenue and income of the fisherman affected as they are not able to export

- Proceeds donated as part of the regional restoration fund in Kitalbaraki



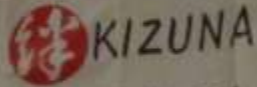

- Exchange with local people – Dinner party









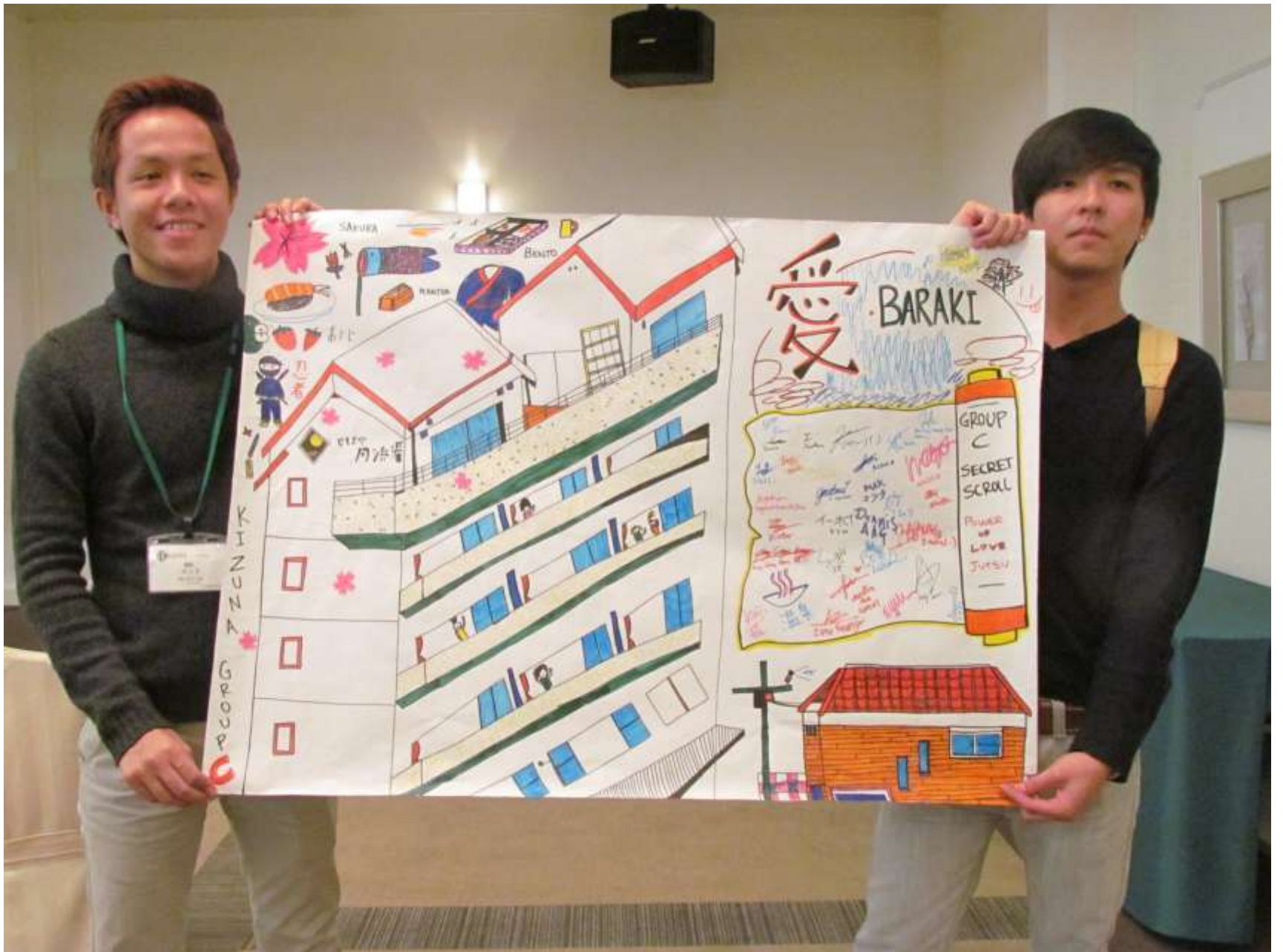
