Mr. Tatsuo Sato joined the Ministry of International Trade & Industry (METI) in 1984 and held several director positions. From July 2007, he served as the Director of the Trade Control Policy Division, Trade Control Department and from July 2009, the Director of the Policy Planning and Coordination Division, Nuclear and Industrial Safety Agency. He was posted as the Vice President of Japan Nuclear Energy Safety Organization (JNES) from August 2010.

JNES aims to establish the basis to ensure the nuclear safety in nuclear utilization for energy by performing the safety analysis, evaluation, etc. of the design of nuclear installations and nuclear reactor facilities, while conducting the inspection etc. of nuclear installations and nuclear reactor facilities.
