Overview

Railways, especially the High Speed Rail (HSR), have attracted worldwide attention as a form of environmentally friendly mass transportation system. HSR projects have been carried out in some countries, while plans for their construction are underway in many others, including Singapore. The purpose of this exhibition is to demonstrate how Japan's 50 years of experiences in HSR operation can contribute to the development of HSR projects in Singapore and to enhance partnership in railway fields between Singapore and Japan.

In this exhibition, which is separated into Technical and Culture Zones, you can learn about the technology of the Japanese bullet train, called the Shinkansen, and gain access to information on products and tourism related to this high-speed rail.
