To Visitors of the Consular Section

Starting from 25 February 2020, the following temporary changes have been implemented to the Consular Section's operations. From 15 April 2020 onwards, Consular Services will be available by appointment only.

1 Appointment (Passport, Certificates, Family Registry related documentation, Visa)

Please make an appointment via the designated e-mail addresses **before** visiting our Embassy. We will send a reply with a confirmed date and time of appointment after receiving the e-mail.

2 Passport, Certificates, Family Registry related documentation

(1) Processing time for Passport Issuing

5 working days from the day of application.

(Eg : Application on Monday→Collection on Friday)

(2) Processing time for Certificate Issuing

The following applicable certificates can be issued within 3 working days from the day of application.

【Applicable Certificates】

- ① Personal Documentation (Birth, Marriage, Divorce, Death Certificates etc.)
- ② Driver's License Extract Certificate
- ③ Others (Zairyū todokedezumī shōmei-sho etc.)

However, same day issuance is available for Residence and Signature Certificates.

- (3) Voting Registration for Overseas Electors can be accepted without prior appointment (8:30am to 12:00pm and 1:30pm to 4:00pm). Please inform the security staff that you are entering the embassy premises for the purpose of voting registration.

3 Others

Humanitarian and urgent cases will be handled with priority on a case by case basis. We will endeavor to continue to provide consular services as before, so please do not hesitate to contact the Consular Section if you have any queries.
