## Export of meats such as beef, pork, etc. for personal consumption in hand luggage from Japan to Singapore

Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries of Japan and its Singapore counterpart have just agreed on the simplified form of certificate which is necessary for travellers to export beef, pork and their products produced in Japan to Singapore for personal consumption carried in hand luggage.

From today, it is allowed to bring into Singapore beef, pork and their products which are bought at airports in Japan, without border inspections at animal quarantine services in airport, etc., if they are not more than 5kg, are for personal consumption and are attached with simplified form of certificates on them.

In addition, it is also allowed to bring into Singapore beef, pork and their products which are bought at shops outside airport in Japan, after they have simplified form of certificates attached on them at animal quarantine services in airport, etc., as long as they are not more than 5kg, are for personal consumption and can be identified as products of Japan by labelling, etc.
